Dear Josef,

I was astonished to read the very general grounds / comments from the referees, on the basis of which

Cambridge Journal has refused publication. I quite agree with you that we should not revise the paper in the light of the criticisms made by the referees; rather we send it for publication elsewhere.

I must admit that I was not even aware of the existence of the British Journal of Economic Issues. I don't mind publishing it there, if you think it is a good idea. There are two other alternatives:

(i) to send it to Monthly Review in New York. It has a wide audience and I think, the subject matter would suit them. I would have some preference for it in case you think this to be O.K. Another alternative is New Left Review in London.

(ii) Alternatively, we could send it to a more "academic" Journal like Journal of Post
