Of the many novelties, the most
 striking one, to my mind, is
 the effect of trade unions on the
 degree of monopoly. It occurs to
 me that the post-war Census of
 Manufacturers (1947) seems to show
 an increase in share of wages in
 value added, at least as compared
 with 1939. That probably would
 mean also a decline in mark-ups.
