Dear Steindl,

Thank you very much for your letter, your postcard and your book which I all found on my arrival from my holiday. I find very interesting your project of applying the method you developed in your book concerning the Pareto Law in application to firms to the problem of distribution of incomes; and although I have only a general idea of this method I have an impression that you will succeed.

Now to raise another point. Professor Laski whom you happen to know from his stay in Vienna intends to leave this <sup>u</sup>country in the near future. Judging from a letter you wrote to me at the end of the last year there might be a possibility of an opening for him at your Institute - at least for some time.
